The number of pupils at the school has continued to remain strong at around 185 on roll.

We are now well into the current academic year and all the staff and pupils continue to work hard. The regular school parentmail provide updates on the daily life of the school, including the events taking place and updates on staff changes. The school facebook page is also another area where we can share pictures and updates on the life of the school with parents and the wider community.

The governors were extremely pleased that the Ofsted inspection in 16/17 rated us as a Good school across all areas and we thank all the staff in achieving this outcome. We will continue to build upon this success during 17/18.

For the 2017/18 academic year the following meetings have been scheduled. This will enable regular involvement by the governors in the strategic review of the school to enable them to better monitor, challenge and support the school leadership team and staff.
