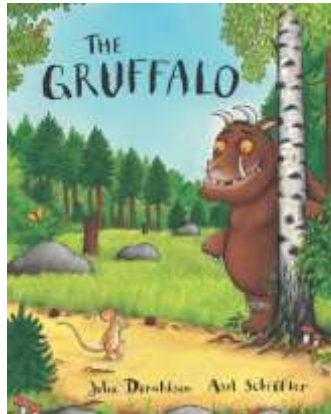

All families are made up of people who love us and look after us.

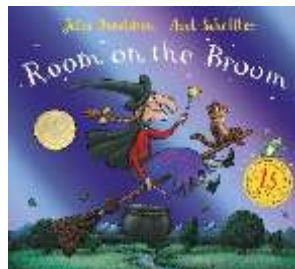
