

Trowbridge Youth Parliament

The Trowbridge Youth Parliament (TYP), was set up several years ago to give a voice to all the young people in Trowbridge and its surrounding areas. It is made up of two Y5/6 representatives from each of the primary schools and three representatives from Y7/8 from each of the secondary schools - 22 schools in all. The representatives are elected by the whole school. Each candidate prepares a speech explaining why they feel they should represent the school. Following this, all the children vote and our reps are elected!

Over the years, the TYP reps have led the school in;

- an anti-social behaviour campaign;
- creating mosaics, linked to the Olympics for Trowbridge Park;
- fundraising as a group of schools for the RSPCA;
- organising a musical event at the civic hall in which all schools participated;
- creating a garden area in Trowbridge Park;
